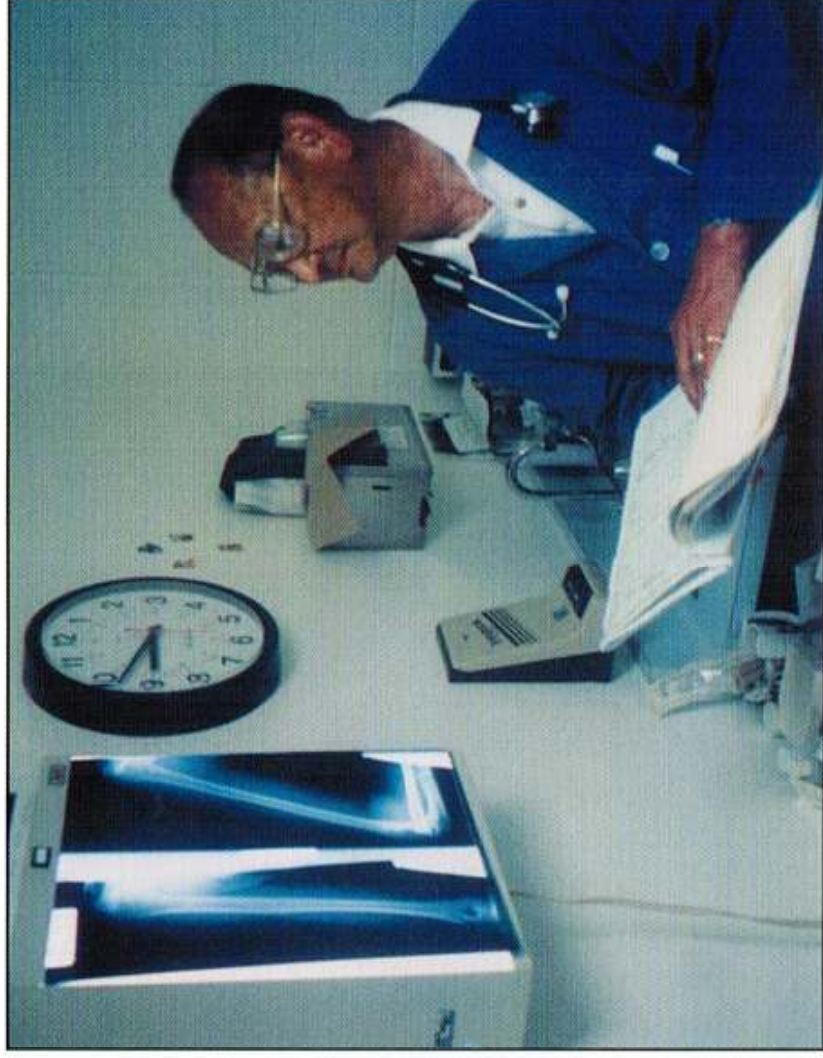


The Wisconsin Department of Corrections does,
