I'm pleased to invite you to AFT-Wisconsin's 84th annual convention, which will be held at the Radisson Hotel in Madison from Friday, October 23, through Sunday, October 25. Members of the AFT-Wisconsin Convention Committee and AFT-Wisconsin staff have been working hard to put together an engaging, informative, and practical program. Our goal is to allow delegates and guests to share strategies, ideas, and best practices from their local unions, and to help members develop solidarity with other dedicated AFT-Wisconsin leaders and activists from around the state. Please note: the Joint Luncheon and COPE Reception require a small admission fee to attend. The Joint Luncheon cost is \$16, and admission to the COPE Reception is \$10 before October 10, or \$15 at the door. I'd like to extend a special invitation to our Committee on Political Education [COPE] Reception, a fundraiser for our AFT-Wisconsin political program.
